



Together: The largest shipment of medical cannabis landed in Israel this morning

Together increases its local market presence with 1.7 tons which arrived from the farm in Uganda

The medical cannabis company Together announced that it today received approx. 1.7 tons of medical cannabis comprised of THC-enriched strains designated for the domestic market. The medical cannabis, which comes from the Company's production plant in Uganda, is in high demand in Israel, and the Company estimates that this the largest shipment of medical cannabis to reach Israel to date, and one of the largest in the world.

Together estimates a sales value exceeding NIS 20 per gram, such that together with the variety of high standard strains grown in an excellent climate for medical cannabis, the forecast is for a gross profit of tens of millions of NIS.

Currently, Together's medical cannabis is sold in pharmacies in Israel, including the Super-Pharm chain, and it even has exclusive marketing and distribution agreements with the Good Pharm pharmacy chain and Sarel medical services. Recently, the Company announced that its local plant in the Ashkelon area passed the infrastructure test for compliance with the IMC-GMP standard of the Israel Medical Cannabis Agency at the Ministry of Health. After the launch, and with the shift to independent production without third party involvement, an additional increase of the Company's profitability is expected.

Together CEO, Nissim Bracha: "Together continues working towards the breakthrough year of 2021 to realize the Company's business strategy of involvement in the entire value chain. Increasing market presence, our ability to produce and market shipments of a historic size, and the continued growing operations and domestic development at the farm alongside the commercial agreements we signed, constitute landmarks in making the Company a leading player in the domestic and global medical cannabis market".
